We are inviting post-graduate students in computer science to submit full and short papers to this long-standing conference.

Paper submission deadline has been extended to 18 January 2015!

The CS CON 2015 is shaping up to be an awesome event. This is a great opportunity for students to showcase their work, network and collaborate with their peers, industry representatives and experts in their domain. It is also a great opportunity to learn, connect and explore future prospects.

In addition to the main research track, CS CON 2015 will feature skills workshops, opportunities to mix with industry, and a special session on women in tech, joined by Rane Johnston-Stempson from Microsoft Research. There will also be great prizes including the best poster, lightning talks, and full paper presentation.

Conference attendees presenting a paper, poster or lightning talk are eligible to apply for a travel grant, contingent to pre-registration on the website. Full registration process and travel scholarship details will be announced in early January 2015.

Full papers (with presentation) not exceeding 8 pages.
Short papers (with poster/lightning talk) not exceeding 4 pages.

All papers must be in PDF format and follow the ACM style guidelines: http://www.acm.org/sigs/publications/proceedings-templates



Papers will be submitted through EasyChair: https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=nzcsrsc2015

Papers must be written by a student author and reflect the student's own research. Papers can contain research in progress i.e. research does not need to be complete for a paper to be accepted. Papers may be co-authored as long as the primary author is a Computer Science research student at the time of submission and is affiliated with a New Zealand university. Papers extending work published in previous NZCSRSC are also accepted, provided the advancement is significant.

The NZCSRSC is a peer-reviewed conference. By submitting a paper, each student author agrees to be a reviewer. For each paper an author submits, they will receive two/three papers to review during the review period.
